
I've said, "What do you talk about?"

I know plenty of people who see and hear and experience things differently than I do. And my response is similar to each. Keep looking. Keep listening. Keep your eyes and your soul open. And if you ever experience communication that tells you to do something you know is harmful to you or

anyone, then that's not a good voice to listen to.


