I wanted to update you on the sanctuary lighting project. The Trustees have been working with Imperial Lighting to try to find ways to save some money on their original quote. The exchange of ideas has resulted in a lower cost to complete the project. We are now working on finalizing a start date. As you can imagine, a project like this one does not come with a small price tag. The logistics involved include removing pews so that a large lift can be set up at various spots in the Sanctuary. Each lightbulb can then be changed, and then the pews replaced. This process accounts for a large portion of the budget. Once complete, each light fixture will now be fitted with an energy efficient LED bulb. It will be nice to have a fully lit Sanctuary again!

During the recent Christmas season, you may have noticed that the church Christmas trees were looking a bit "tired." I am asking church members to consider underwriting the cost of a new tree. One of our church families has already agreed to pay for the replacement of the large tree in the Sanctuary. We are looking to replace seven additional six-foot trees that will be displayed in the Narthex and Chapel. Please contact the church office if you are interested in participating in our Christmas Tree replacement program.

We have many upcoming events, including a charcuterie board

preparation program by the Peace Memorial Cooking Club, and the beginning of our pickleball program. 
PMC Peace Pickleball
